Club Emergency Action Plan

Emergency

MINOR (Green)

Emergency Services are not needed

Ensure that you and crew
are safe and in a safe
location

Provide First Aid as
required

If further treatment is
needed follow **ORANGE**
procedure

If no further treatment is
needed report to HHYC Base
(turn over for contact
details)

ASSISTANCE (Orange)

Further assistance is
needed without Emergency
Services

Ensure that you and crew
are safe and in a safe
location

If the Emergency Services
are required follow **RED**
procedure

If Emergency Services are not
needed call HHYC
Base and explain nature of
problem

Treat any casualty and
provide regular checks and
observation

If no further assistance is
required, report to HHYC
Base and discuss whether
to continue or abandon task

MAJOR (Red)

Emergency Services are
required

Ensure that you and crew
are safe and in a safe
location

Contain incident and move
people to safe location if
required

Call Emergency Services
(Marine Department) on VHF
Channel 16 or phone 999 and
explain nature of
Emergency

Treat any casualty and
move to suitable Evac point
if directed or follow
Emergency Services
instructions

Wait for assistance

When possible, report to HHYC
Base (turn over
for contact details)

Vessel Fire Action

- Stop engine and if possible, shut off fuel cock
- Jettison any burning objects or fuel if safe to do so
- Apply fire extinguisher to base of fire if safe to do so
- Call Emergency Services (Hong Kong Marine Police) on VHF Channel 16 or phone 999
- Abandon vessel as a last resort, taking any suitable equipment to hand.

Hours of Darkness

- Ensure that you are visible to all other shipping / vessels
- Prepare torch (and flares) for collision avoidance or location identification if required
