Conditions of Dinghy Hire

Age Limits

- Children under the age of 14 must not venture outside the “Inner Port Shelter “area i.e. beside the moorings unless participating in a supervised club event (Saturday racing or practice sessions) or with an approved safety boat.
- Children under the age of 14 are required to have parent’s written consent to sail.

APPROVED HELM INDEMNITY**

As an approved helm, I have read all the rules governing the hire of sailing dinghies from HHYC, as outlined on the “Approved Helm Application Form,” and agree to abide by them at all times when hiring sailing dinghies from the Club. I also agree that I, and any person sailing with me, whether as my crew, or otherwise, accept that HHYC will not be held responsible for any personal injuries, fatal or otherwise, or loss or damage to personal items that may be sustained as a result of using a hired sailing vessel.* Regardless of whether such use is in relation to racing, or any other type of use, HHYC will not be held liable for any costs arising; and in this respect I shall indemnify HHYC from any costs that may result from use of a club sailing dinghy. I make this agreement in full knowledge of the risks inherent to sailing.

* Please be reminded that no helm under 18 years of age may be responsible for any friends or siblings when on the water.

You must pre-book your boat with the STC otherwise boats may not be available

Members renting a club sailing dinghy are reminded that they are responsible for returning the dinghy to the Club in the same condition in which was checked-out. The boat should be checked by the member before use and any defects or missing equipment should be reported to a member of the Sail Training Centre staff.

If it is found on return that the dinghy is damaged or has lost equipment, the member hiring the dinghy on that particular day will be responsible for the repair and/or replacement of any lost or damaged equipment. It is therefore in the member’s interest to check the dinghy properly before use. Failure to report any damage to STC will result in an automatic charge to your account.
