BW 07	<b>Henriot, Brut Souverain N.V. (WS-92, WE-91)</b> <i>Lovely balance, with a lacy texture and a fine frame of acidity enlivening the rich flavors of toasted brioche, baked plum, graphite, crystallized honey and ground anise. Offers a smoky, lingering finish.</i>	\$840
BW 16	<b>Philippe Prié Champagne Brut Tradition N.V.</b> <i>At the begging vegetal and white flowers, then it evolves into white fruits (peaches, pears) and quince paste. The palate is balanced with a fleshy structure. We find tangy aromas of citrus and roasting. The finish is long and sustained.</i>	\$780

BW 04	<b>Marquise de Leroy-Beauval, Cremant de Bordeaux Brut N.V.</b> – <i>Bordeaux, France</i> <i>Rich in thin bubbles, regular and lingering bubbles. Reminiscent of white flowers and aromas of pear and green apple.</i>	\$360
BW 17	<b>Fantinel The Independent Prosecco Brut DOC N.V.</b> – <i>Friuli, Italy</i> <i>Light straw yellow with lime green glare. Intense and elegant, rich of flowery notes and delicate fruity extracts, thanks to its subtle perlage.</i>	\$340
BW 18	<b>Miolo Winery ‘Cuvee Tradition’ Brut N.V.</b> – <i>VALE DOS VINHEDOS, BRAZIL</i> <i>Excellent as an aperitif and for a commemorative toast. Green salads leaves and tomato (without vinegar), carpaccio, fish roe, seafood. The effervescence and acidity harmonize with greasy foods and those with a tendency for sweetness.</i>	\$230
BW 19	<b>Vilarnau Sleever Brut Reserva Rosé Delicat Organic CAVA DO N.V.</b> – <i>D.O. PENEDES, Spain</i> <i>On the nose, it displays the primary aromas that are typical of a delicate rosé cava: the subtleties of violets and roses in combination with ripe red berries: strawberries, raspberries and blueberries. On the palate it is smooth, very creamy, fresh and elegant.</i>	\$230

PW 07	<b>Château de l’Aumérade ‘Aumerade Style’ Rosé Côtes de Provence 2022</b> – <i>Cotes De Provence, France</i> <i>The nose is elegant and fine with aromas of apricot and white melon. In the mouth, a great deal of elegance and fat. A fresh wine, silky and intense with a fine aromatic persistence.</i>	\$310

## France

WW 03	<b>Bouchard Père &amp; Fils, Meursault, Domaine 2020</b> – <i>Burgundy, France</i> <i>Exhibiting aromas of crisp Anjou pear, dried white flowers, beeswax and blanched almonds. On the palate, the wine is medium to full-bodied, satiny and incisive, with an elegantly chalky finish.</i>	\$1,080
WW 25	<b>Domaine Philippe Colin, Chassagne Montrachet 2018</b> – <i>Burgundy, France (WS-92)</i> <i>A smooth-textured white, studded with peach, vanilla cream and lime blossom aromas and flavors. Balanced, with bright acidity carrying the finish.</i>	\$980
WW 38	<b>Domaine Roblin Sancerre AOC 2021</b> – <i>Loire, France</i> <i>This wine displays aromas of fresh lemon and grapefruit that set the stage for a highly refreshing, bright mouthful and finish.</i>	\$660
WW 39	<b>Château du Cray Montagny 1er Cru Chardonnay Le Cornevent MONOPOLE 2021</b> – <i>Burgundy, France</i> <i>It offers a nuanced bouquet of hazelnuts and ferns, a very dry taste with mineral notes and a very good length. The terroir often gives it spicy flavors. Age makes it a bit more golden and spicier. On the palate, its aromas keep their freshness for a long time.</i>	\$600
WW 26	<b>Domaine William Fevre, Chablis 2021</b> – <i>Burgundy, France (JS-93, WE-92)</i> <i>This is really bright and clear with sliced apple, pear and stone. Some chalk, too. It's linear and tight. Pretty length and freshness.</i>	\$560
WW 18	<b>Michel Bouzereau et Fils, Bourgogne Chardonnay 2016</b> – <i>Burgundy, France (RP-85)</i> <i>The palate is simple but nicely balanced, a little nutty and smoky in style and perhaps short, though there is decent depth here and a touch of spice on the aftertaste.</i>	\$530
WW 10	<b>Domaine Pascal &amp; Nicolas Reverdy, Sancerre, Cuvée Terre de Maimbray 2019</b> – <i>Lorie Valley, France</i> <i>This Sancerre with the bouquet and mineral on the nose. On the palate, it is crisp with notes of citrus and spice. The finish is fresh, long and balanced with flavours of dried fruit.</i>	\$440

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# White Wine

## Italy

- WW 40 **La Roncaia ‘Eclisse’ Bianco, Venezia Giulia IGT, Sauvignon & Picolit 2021** \$710  
– *Friuli, Italy*  
*Freshness and minerality combine with a good smoothness, in a body showing harmony, big depth and persistence.*
- WW 41 **Cantine Pellegrino Il Salinaro Grillo DOC 2022** \$310  
– *Sicily, Italy*  
*Straw-yellow with greenish reflections, delicate aromas of citrus blended with herbaceous notes and slight hints of peach and green apple, intense, moderately warm with a pleasant softness.*
- WW 30 **Trebbiano/Vermentino “Luminoso”, Maremma Toscana I.G.T. 2020** \$310  
– *Italy*  
*The wine has fresh citrus, apricot, peach, and pine nut aromas with mineral nuances from the soil. It’s a textured and fresh wine that pairs well with pasta, fish, and vegetarian dishes.*

## Germany

- WW 42 **Schloss Reinhartshausen Erbach Marcobrunn Riesling Kabinett lieblich 2018** \$580  
– *Rheingau, Germany*  
*A seductive scent of citrus fruits, apricots and quinces promises richness, fullness of fruit and lots of extract in the nose. The palate shows pronounced fruit with a fine mineral structure. The wine is underpinned by its crystal-clear acidity.*
- WW 33 **Kunstler Hochheimer Reichstal Riesling Kabinett 2020** \$380  
– *Rheingau, Germany (WA92)*  
*A fruity cabinet with fresh, tropical aromas of pineapple, papaya and peach on the nose. On the palate, the animating, fresh acidity with the opulent residual sweetness ensures a harmonious balance.*

## Portugal

- WW 43 **Churchill’s Estate Douro Branco 2021** \$360  
– *Douro, Portugal*  
*Pale lime-lemony colour. A distinctive mineral nose with hints of graphite and fresh lemons on the background. On the palate, juicy and elegant, showing fresh citrus flavours in a long and refreshing finish.*
- WW 24 **Casal Garcia, Vinho Verde N.V.** \$190  
– *Minho, Portugal*  
*Notes of citrus are amongst the fruity aromas that define the freshness and youth of this limpid and delicate wine.*

## Australia

- WW 13 **Singlefile, Denmark Family Reserve Chardonnay 2019** \$620  
– *Western Australia, Australia*  
*Aromas of intense grapefruit and white peach with a touch of orange blossom. The palate experiences a concentration of citrus and stone fruit with a touch of creamy nutty texture due to a partial malo-lactic fermentation. The wine is effortlessly mouth filling with a delicate balance of fruit and acidity and a long lingering finish.*

# White Wine

## New Zealand

- WW 44 **Seifried Chardonnay 2016** \$380  
– *Nelson, New Zealand*  
*Supple and elegant. –e nose has warm toasted hazelnuts, summer stone fruits and brioche notes. –e palate is mouth-filling with layers of richness and subtle background spice with French oak notes. –The wine leaves a long flavourful finish.*
- WW 45 **Seifried Sauvignon Blanc 2022** \$380  
– *Nelson, New Zealand*  
*Lively and flavourful. Nettle, gooseberry and dried hops dene the generous nose. Layers of varietal fruit and a zesty thread of minerally acid run the palate leaving a long, crisp finish.*
- WW 46 **Seifried Pinot Gris 2018** \$320  
– *Nelson, New Zealand*  
*–The nose has fresh autumn pear and gentle spice. –e palate is full and textured with lingering stone fruit characters.*

## USA

- WW 07 **Banshee, Chardonnay 2019** \$400  
– *Sonoma Coast, USA (WW-92, JS-91)*  
*This coastal wine has zippy acidity that bounces on the palate and plays nicely with the honeysuckle, lemon and citrus blossom flavors with hints of cedar and minerality.*
- WW 47 **Geyser Peak Chardonnay 2021** \$360  
– *California, United States*  
*The nose shows ripe peach with lemon, hazelnut and vanilla, typical of the Geyser Peak style. These are complemented by subtle nuances of toasted barrel, buttery malolactic and vanillin characters.*

## South Africa

- WW 31 **Ken Forrester Vineyards, Reserve Chenin Blanc 2020** \$380  
– *Stellenbosch, South Africa (DC91)*  
*This wine is a great example of the harmonious balance which can be achieved between fruit and delicate oak/vanilla flavours, as they combine to form complex, soft flavours with sufficient body to enhance even spicy and full flavoured meals.*

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# Red Wine

## France

RW 44	<b>Château Cantenac Brown 2012</b> – <b>3ème Cru Classé Margaux, France (WE-93)</b> <i>Aromas of blackberry cream and cherries, blended with notes of smoke and vanilla. On the palate with a soft and creamy attack, followed by fine and silky tannins.</i>	\$970
RW 45	<b>Château Lagrange 2013</b> – <b>3ème Cru Classé St. Julien, France (WE-93)</b> <i>Pure aromas, slightly floral with cassis, red currants and tobacco. Good grip on the palate, pure fruit, good extract and freshness, red and dark berry notes, long and fresh finish.</i>	\$920
RW 46	<b>Henri Magnien, Gevrey Chambertin 2017</b> – <b>Burgundy, France (VNS-88)</b> <i>Lovely brambly red fruit on the nose, which is nicely defined with attractive sous-bois character. The medium-bodied palate offers sappy red fruit, a fine bead of acidity and a touch of soy toward the finish.</i>	\$900
RW 61	<b>Château Rolland-Maillet Saint-Emilion 2018</b> – <b>Bordeaux, France</b> <i>Dark red. Smoky dark cherry, mocha and minerals on the nose. Suave, sweet and perfumed, with a juicy quality to the black cherry, licorice and spice flavors. Finishes firmly tannic but not dry, with noteworthy intensity and thrust. A very good showing.</i>	\$780
RW 60	<b>Maison Les Alexandrins Saint-Joseph 2020</b> – <b>AOC Saint-Joseph, Vallée du Rhône, France (WS-93)</b> <i>An intense bouquet that still requires a little time to reveal its full extent. Elegant and powerful on the palate, it offers peppery and black fruit notes and very present, precise and delicate tannins, finely balanced by a beautiful minerality.</i>	\$600
RW 62	<b>Château du Cray Bourgogne Pinot Noir Le Cornevent MONOPOLE 2021</b> – <b>Burgundy, France</b> <i>The wine and silky on flavors of red fruits dominated by strawberries and cherries. Pinot Noir Le Cornevent is a rather round wine, with assertive but delicate tannins, which will soften over time.</i>	\$600
RW 40	<b>Vincent Girardin, Chorey-lès-Beaune “Les Beaumonts” AOC, 2017</b> – <b>Burgundy, France (WE-92)</b> <i>Red fruits, especially morello cherry and raspberry, with a woody and spicy note with a touch of pepper. The tannic structure is fine, silky but well present. This beautiful balance persists for a very long time in the mouth and lets you appreciate the equilibrium and the fine woodiness.</i>	\$590

# Red Wine

## Italy

- RW 64 **La Roncaia 'Fusco' Merlot Friuli Colli Orientali DOC 2017** \$710  
– *Friuli, Italy*  
*A multi-layered aromatic set, merging typically herbaceous scents and intense perfumes of red berries, in a fine, clean and elegant complexity. Structurally balanced, warm, smooth, appropriately tannic; An engrossing and long-lasting wine.*
- RW 63 **Aristocraton Amarone Della Valpolicella DOCG 2019** \$590  
– *Veneto, Italy*  
*Complex with notes of ripe fruit, tobacco and spices. Round with sophisticated aromas and soft tannins.*
- RW 65 **Cantine Pellegrino Tripudium Nero d'Avola IGT 2016** \$400  
– *Sicily, Italy*  
*Bright red with crimson reflections. Aroma: intense, elegant, complex. Marked notes of ripe red fruit, particularly cherry and prune, accompanied by hints of almond, bitter orange and star anise. Moderately warm, fresh, soft and captivating.*
- RW 49 **Monte Zovo Ripasso della Valpolicella Superiore D.O.C. 2019** \$310  
– *Italy*  
*The wine undergoes a second fermentation on Amarone's marc and is aged for 24 months in wood vessels. It has aromas of ripe fruits, flowers, and spices, and is smooth, balanced, and full-bodied on the palate.*

## Germany

- RW 66 **Schloss Reinhartshausen Erbacher Spätburgunder trocken 2018** \$310  
– *Rheingau, Germany*  
*Our local wine comes exclusively from officially classified vineyards in Erbach. This Pinot Noir is reminiscent of the taste of cherries, a touch of chocolate and mild woody notes, it is elegant and fruity with a cool taste.*

## Spain

- RW 53 **Vina Real Reserva 2016** \$550  
– *Rioja, Spain*  
*The palate reveals a well-structured wine with firm but polished, rounded tannins and notes of fruit compote and elegant oak. The long finish adds to the ability of the wine to age well for a considerable time on bottle.*
- RW 67 **Bodegas Beronia Reserva Rioja DOCa 2018** \$450  
– *Rioja, Spain*  
*Full bodied the palate, the wine displays balanced acidity. The flavors are mostly of ripe fruit, whilst the finish is sweet and smooth, bringing to mind cacao and roasted hazelnuts.*
- RW 68 **Bodegas Beronia Crianza Rioja DOCa 2019** \$310  
– *Rioja, Spain*  
*It is complex on the nose, with aromas of cherry and raspberry standing out, complemented with aromatic notes of herbs such as thyme, rosemary, cinnamon and tobacco. On the palate it is a very fresh wine, voluminous pleasant and with a long finish.*
- RW 69 **Vinas del Vero La Miranda De Secastilla Garnacha Rojo 2018** \$280  
– *Somontano, Spain*  
*The wine displays a violet edge that is characteristic of carefully made Garnacha. On the nose, it displays intense aromas that bring to mind sharp red fruits, complemented by wild flowers. The wine is smooth on the palate, pleasant and flavorful.*

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# Red Wine

## Portugal

- RW 70 Churchill's Touriga Nacional Douro 2015 \$400  
– *Douro, Portugal*  
*Deep black violet hue. On the nose, intense fresh spicy aromas with hints of wild basil and gum cistus. Velvety and well balanced on the palate, combining notes of green peppers and resinous notes with an excellent natural acidity.*
- RW 71 Churchill's Estate Douro Tinto 2019 \$360  
– *Douro, Portugal*  
*Deep garnet color, intense nose of dry herbs and black cherries. On the palate, rich and well-structured on the palate, with juicy flavors of spices with hints of nutmeg and tea leaf.*

## Australia

- RW 39 Powell & Son, Barossa Valley Shiraz 2018 \$700  
– *Barossa Valley, Australia (WE-90)*  
*Notes of tar and graphite follow with hints of dried herbs and tobacco. The palate is rounded and supple with dark fruits and a supple tannin backbone which brings with it coffee ground and cedar flavours. The wine finishes with generous dark fruits and white pepper spice.*
- RW 72 Longview 'Yakka' Shiraz 2021 \$470  
– *Adelaide Hills, Australia*  
*Dark violet hue, with lifted aromas of raspberries and plum, anise and baking spices. The palate is plush, and tannins are silky smooth with well-integrated oak characters. Excellent to drink now and will benefit with 10+ years cellaring.*
- RW 10 Domaine Tournon by M. Chapoutier, Shays Flat Vineyard, Shiraz 2015 \$430  
– *Victoria, Australia*  
*Bright and focused shiraz with berry, asphalt and basil-leaf aromas and flavors. Medium to full-bodied. Firm and polished tannins and a flavorful finish. Shows tightness and focus.*
- RW 41 JJ Hahn, Stelzer Road Merlot 2018 \$300  
– *Barossa Valley, Australia (JH-91)*  
*Fully expressive with black fruits, fruit cake spice, violets and savoury aromas. This is not one of those pretty merlots but rather a thumping, shiraz-like interpretation. However the finish, with edgy garrique herbals, is a reminder of some of the grape's celebrated elegance.*

## New Zealand

- RW 73 Seifried Pinot Noir 2021 \$380  
– *Nelson, New Zealand*  
*Rich and ripe with lovely depth and weight. Entry is succulent with dark berry fruits and a generous concentrated palate. Strong, rich blackberry and cinnamon flavours linger and leave a long lasting impression on the palate.*
- RW 74 Seifried Merlot 2013 \$380  
– *Nelson, New Zealand*  
*Bright with juicy, succulent berry fruits. The palate is smooth with nicely integrated spicy oak tannins and notes of coffee. A generous finish that lingers on the palate.*
- RW 08 Lawson's Dry Hills, Pinot Noir 2018 \$360  
– *Marlborough, New Zealand*  
*The wine has a lovely burgundy hue and a warm, inviting nose of strawberry, raspberry and a touch of smoky, vanillin oak. Ripe berry flavours are matched with a lovely soft mouthfeel and fine silky tannins.*



# Red Wine

## USA

- RW 75 **Geyser Peak Walking Tree Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County 2019** \$480  
– *California, United States*  
*The deep plum color of this sumptuous Cabernet Sauvignon gives way to expressive aromas of white pepper, dark berry fruit, and cassis. Aging in French oak barrels softens the otherwise firm tannins and introduces hints of toasted vanilla and leather on the palate.*
- RW 50 **Angels & Cowboys Proprietary Red 2018** \$420  
– *Sonoma County, California, USA*  
*It has a firm structure, smooth tannins, and ripe fruit flavors of figs, dark plums, cherries, and raspberries.*

## Chile

- RW 54 **Aquitania Cabernet Sauvignon 2019** \$300  
– *Maipo Valley, Chile*  
*On the palate it is smooth, with round tannins and long persistence, highlighting its fruit flavor combined with the wood provided by its aging in barrels.*

## Brazil

- RW 76 **Miolo Winery ‘Lote 43’ Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot 2020** \$530  
– *Vale Dos Vinhedos, Brazil*  
*Highly aromatic with intense notes of plum, tobacco, truffles, cocoa, cloves and subtle and elegant tertiary aromas. The rounded tannins, together with the correct level of acidity and excellently ripened fruit, provide a unique freshness and an unequal balance for the enjoyment thereof.*
- RW 77 **Miolo Winery Merlot Terrior 2020** \$530  
– *Vale Dos Vinhedos, Brazil*  
*High aromatic intensity and an excellent cherry harmony with oak notes such as caramel, cocoa, coffee and vanilla. Structured elegant and velvety tannins, with great volume in the mouth.*

## Argentina

- RW 78 **Bodega Colomé Lote Especial Malbec La Brava 2021** \$430  
– *Salta, Argentina*  
*This Malbec comes from La Brava Estate, located in Cafayate at 1700m above sea level. Bright red, with aromas highlighting mature black and red fruits. Concentrated and complex, it is fresh, with good volume on the palate.*
- RW 79 **Bodega Colomé Lote Especial Tannat 2021** \$420  
– *Salta, Argentina*  
*Very dark in colour, it has nose with notes of black fruit, and concentrated and elegant spicy notes. It highlights freshness and rounded tannins that set it apart from the Tannat that comes from Salta.*

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
